The degradation of Jesmond Wood continues. Earlier this month, 46 trees were cut down and undergrowth destroyed, with a devastating effect on our wildlife. This has been closely followed by a new application for **another +50 trees** to be felled soon. **There is no reason to fell them.**

You still have time to raise your objections to the TPO planning application on this vital wildlife corridor at the heart of Highcliffe's local green spaces.
